PERMISSION TO KEEP BEES IN AN URBAN AREA - KEEPING OF ANIMALS, BEES AND POULTRY BYLAW 2010

I am pleased to advise that the Kapiti Coast District Council has **given permission** for you to keep bees at **51 Elizabeth Street, Waikanae**, subject to the following conditions:

- Maximum number of occupied hives per urban lot limited to 3
- No occupied hives located on an urban lot smaller than 400m²
- No occupied hives located within 1.0 metre of a residential property boundary.
Note: This may be reduced if there is a fence of 2.0 metres in height between the adjoining properties.
- Hives are to be generally located as shown in your application (drawing attached).

Please be aware that this permission may be revoked pursuant to provision 8.2 of the above Bylaw, which states:

8.2 Permission to keep bees may be revoked if the conditions for which the permission was originally given are not being met, or nuisance complaints from two or more different adjoining property owners have been received

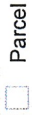
